

MIDLAND COUNTY CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES For 2016 - 2017

Each year, the Midland County Educational Service Agency in partnership with Bullock Creek School District, Coleman Community Schools, Meridian Public Schools and Midland Public Schools, offers Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs at different sites throughout the county. These programs are designed to prepare youth for a broad range of employment and advanced training/educational opportunities and are offered under the guidance of certified instructors, counselors, and administrators.

The following CTE programs are available to high school students in Midland County for the 2016-2017 school year:

Accounting/Finance & Financial Management	11 th or 12 th grade (selectively open to 10 th grade) Career interest in accounting, finance, or financial management.	Midland Public Schools
Agriscience	11 th or 12 th grade (selectively open to 9 th and 10 th grade) Career interest in agriculture, natural resources, animal science, plant science, agribusiness, and leadership. Focus on projects in lab, greenhouse, and animal barn.	Coleman Community Schools
Automotive Technology	11 th or 12 th grade (selectively open to 10 th grade) Career interest in automotive technology and mechanics. Program follows national automotive curriculum standards.	Midland Public Schools
Building Construction Trades	11 th or 12 th grade (selectively open to 10 th grade) Career interest in various construction trades such as carpentry, electricity and masonry. Focus on residential construction with students building a house.	Bullock Creek Midland Public Schools
Business Administration, Management & Operations	11 th or 12 th grade (selectively open to 10 th grade) Interest in careers related to business. Focus given to learning all Microsoft Office applications.	Midland Public Schools
Chemical Processing Technology	12 th grade – dual enrollment program at Delta College Interest in a career as a chemical process operator. Completion of Algebra 2 AND completion or concurrent enrollment in Physics required.	Midland County ESA Program held at Delta College
Computer Aided Design (CAD)/Mechanical Design	11 th or 12 th grade (selectively open to 10 th grade) Career interest in CAD, design or engineering. Basic computer skills are recommended.	Midland Public Schools
Digital Multimedia and Information Resource Design	11 th or 12 th grade (selectively open to 10 th grade) Interest in web design and other aspects of multimedia design. Basic computer skills are recommended.	Midland Public Schools
Family & Consumer Science	9 th - 12 th grade Courses include parenthood, human development, food & nutrition, personal living and designing for career & family.	Midland Public Schools
Health Care Technology	11 th or 12 th grade Interest in healthcare career. Ability to complete clinical experience which includes completion of a background check and various health requirements.	Midland Public Schools
Marketing, Sales & Service, and Entrepreneurship	11 th or 12 th grade (selectively open to 10 th grade) Career interest in marketing, sales or entrepreneurship.	Midland Public Schools
Skilled Trades	11 th or 12 th grade Interested in Skilled Trades	Midland County ESA Program Held at Greater Michigan Construction Academy
Welding Technology	11 th or 12 th grade (selectively open to 10 th grade) Interest in welding as a career. Program gives focus to American Welding Society standards.	Midland Public Schools Bullock Creek
